



Rodman/Instrument Man

OBJECTIVE:

A survey Rodman/Instrument man assists the party chiefs while conducting survey related tasks.

Job Description:

- Assist Party Chief in conducting surveys to ascertain the locations of natural features and man-made structures on the Earth's surface, underground, and underwater using electronic distance-measuring equipment and other surveying instruments.
- Perform manual labor, such as cutting brush for lines, carrying stakes, rebar, and other heavy items, and stacking rods.
- Place and hold measuring tapes when electronic distance-measuring equipment is not used.
- Position and hold the vertical rods, or targets, that theodolite operators use for sighting to measure angles, distances, and elevations.
- Record survey measurements and descriptive data using notes, drawings, sketches, and inked tracings.
- Search for corners, property irons, and survey points.
- Set out and recover stakes, marks, and other monumentation.
- Compare survey computations with applicable standards to determine adequacy of data.
- Run rods for benches and cross-section elevations.
