Duties include

Field: tree ID, tree condition assessment, tree metrics – DBH or canopy SF, tree sampling, site condition analysis, GPS surveying, tree tagging, tree photos

Design: proposed tree locations, site disturbance limits, proposed light pole locations, trail alignments
